

# Electrical Safety Recall

Fisher & Paykel Appliances Australia Pty Limited is issuing a recall on certain refrigerators sold in Australia.

## WHAT MODELS ARE AFFECTED?

Refrigerators with model numbers starting with E522B and RF610 and with a serial number starting with the letters LFQ, LHQ, LIQ, LSQ, RAQ, REQ, RHQ, RKQ, RLQ, RPQ, RRQ, RUQ & RYQ are affected. These were manufactured in 2006 and 2007.

## WHERE TO FIND THE SERIAL NUMBER ON THE MACHINE?

The model and serial numbers can be found on the bottom rail as indicated below.

## DEFECT

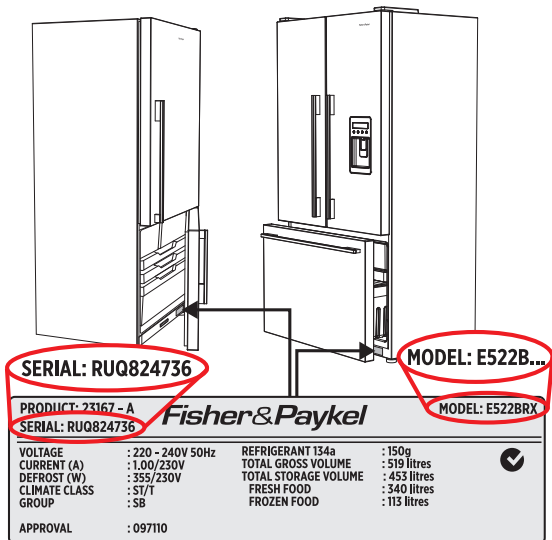
In rare circumstances an electrical connection can overheat in the freezer compartment.

## HAZARD – FIRE

This may cause a fire within the refrigerator.

## WHAT SHOULD I DO

Record the model and serial number on the refrigerator. To confirm whether your refrigerator is affected please either:

- You may continue to use the fresh food section only, until the refrigerator has been serviced by a technician.
