Identifying Features: 1.7L stainless steel kettle with variable temperature control. Affected models include 5KEK1722AAC, 5KEK1722AER, 5KEK1722AOB, 5KEK1722ACU and 5KEK1722ASX and have serial numbers from YA342XXXXX to YA724XXXXX.

Defect: The handle on the kettle may become loose or separate from the body of the kettle.

Hazard: If the handle detaches during use, a consumer could be scalded or burned. The defect has occurred and caused injuries to consumers.

What to do: Check the model and serial number on bottom of your kettle as shown in the picture below. If you have the affected kettle, or are in doubt, immediately stop using the kettle and call 1800 990 990 or visit https://kitchenaid.com/pages/product-safety-recall-kettle-form to arrange for a replacement of affected kettles.
