



## PRODUCT SAFETY RECALL

### Norco Bicycles

Norco Bicycles has identified several models of bicycles where the head tube area of the frame may develop cracks and could cause the head tube to separate from the remainder of the frame, causing a rider to fall from the bicycle and suffer injuries.

**The effected bicycle models are: 2007 Team DH, 2008 Team DH, Aline Park, Aline, Atomik, Shore 1, Shore 2, Shore 3, 2009 Atomik (without gussets) and were distributed in Australia by Sportz Australasia Pty Ltd during the period September 2006 and May 2009.** The model name is printed on a decal on the top tube of each bicycle.

The effected area of the bicycle frame is shown below.



If you purchased one of these bicycles between September 2006 and May 09 -

Immediately ensure that the bicycle is not ridden again and

Contact the current distributor of Norco bicycles in Australia, Pacific Brands Sport & Leisure Pty Ltd, or a local Norco Dealer to arrange for an inspection of the bicycle and the replacement of the frame.
