



PRODUCT RECALL

Sleepmaker Lodger and Village bunk beds

Product Information: The affected products are the Sleepmaker Lodger and the Sleepmaker Village bunk beds. The bunks were sold as single beds but could be purchased to transform them into bunks via a do-it-yourself kit. There is a risk of the structural welds failing which could result in the bunk collapsing causing injury to users. Only the beds that have been converted into bunks are being recalled, the single Lodger and Village beds are unaffected. The bunk can be identified via the following codes located on the frame: Lodger 7375; Village 7257.



Details: It has been discovered that of the 2,000 bunk beds sold, five customers have contacted Sleepmaker to inform it that some of the bunks purchased had experienced welding breakages. For safety reasons, Sleepmaker is recalling all of the 2000 bunks, even though no injuries have occurred.

None of the bunks were sold through retail stores as they were sold through Sleepmaker's Commercial Division to businesses. Some business agents may have on-sold the bunks to private stores. It is only the Sleepmaker Village and Lodger bunks that are affected, no other products in the Sleepmaker range are affected.

Sleepmaker takes matters of product quality very seriously. Accordingly, a thorough review of quality control practices is being completed to ensure that this incident does not occur again.

Action: Customers who have purchased either the Lodger or the Village bunks should cease using the bunks and call Sleepmaker on 1800 835 228 to receive a replacement bunk or to obtain a full refund. Sleepmaker will then collect the bunks from customers.
