



Product Safety Recall



Do you own this product?

QFES Dynamo Torch

White or orange portable torch with pump-action recharging.

Dates sold: Queensland Fire and Emergency Services (QFES) distributed to the public free-of-charge between 2014 and 2023 as a community engagement tool.



Why the product is recalled: These torches are being recalled as they do not comply with new laws for products containing button batteries.

Hazard: The batteries may be exposed if the torch is dropped or damaged. If swallowed by a child, batteries can cause choking, burns or death.



Check if you have one of these torches at home, in the car, or stored in an emergency kit. Any torches found should be safely disposed of immediately.



Check if you have one of these torches at home.

Stop using the torch immediately.

Dispose of the torch and batteries safely.

Options for disposal include:

- B-cycle
- Planet Ark
- Battery World
- Bunnings
- Woolworths



The torches were distributed to the public free of charge at community events, expos, and open days by QFES, Fire and Rescue Service, Rural Fire Service, and State Emergency Service staff and volunteers as a handy item for storage in an emergency kit.
