## Do you own this product?

Kawasaki motorcycle models KX252CNFNN/DNFNN and KX450JNFNN/KNFNN (Manufactured in 2022)



Product can be identified by Vehicle Identification Number stamped on right-hand side of steering head. (Refer to VIN list on [productsafety.gov.au](https://productsafety.gov.au) recall notice.)

Dates sold: 1 June 2021 – 22 March 2023



**Why the product is recalled:** Improper manufacturing of the fuel pump could result in the motorcycle being hard to start.

**Hazard:** There is an increased risk of accident, injury, or death to the rider if the engine stalls and cannot restart.



Owners should not operate their vehicle until they return the affected motorcycle to their original selling dealer, or any authorised Kawasaki dealer, so that the fuel pump can be checked, and replaced if required.
