

# Product Safety Recall

## Bubs Gallery Travel Cot

Sold online between December 2018 and April 2019



Folding Travel Cot (Blue or Pink) model number S12-7

**Defect:** The product does not comply with the mandatory standard 'Trade Practices Act 1974 -Consumer Protection Notice No.4 of 2008 - Consumer Product Safety Standard for Children's Portable Folding Cots.' The safety markings are not satisfactory and are missing required statements including missing information about the locking procedures.

**Hazard:** Missing information may lead to incorrect assembly of the cot and create a risk of injury to small children.

**What to do:** Price Down Gallery Pty Ltd is no longer trading. Affected consumers should print a copy of the 'Permanent Safety Sticker' provided below and attach it to these travel cots.

# Permanent Safety Sticker


## Installation and usage way (to unfold)

1. unzip the zipper on the bag and pull out the playpen. Spread the Velcro belts from the sides and take away the mattress.

2. Lift the short sides of the cot upwards until they lock in to position. Repeat with long sides of cot (step a & b)



3. Check All sides have locked by pressing down at their centres. Push Down centre of the base. Put down the mattress from the up.



## To fold

Remove the crib mattress from the crib (step a) lift the handle in the centre of the base and pull upwards, lift up one rail (long side) gently and press in on the button (as the mark shown) to put the rail down (step b).

(Must be careful : There is double lock system in the base and must be unlocked when you take up the belt as the bottom is lever off).

Repeat for other three rails, after folding, tighten the mattress and pack within the bag. (step c)
