## Kambrook Essentials Microwave Oven 30L (Model KMO400)



Sold nationally through Kmart from 1/9/2008 to 1/9/2013

**Identifying Features:** Affected products have production date code (PDC) 833 to 1321 inclusive. The PDC can be located on the Rating label or in the Serial number (see example below) and will be a 3 or 4 digit number.
