Karinjo Baby Carrier 40634 v2



**Sold at Kathmandu stores nationally between
5 January 2015 and 4 July 2020**

Identifying Features: The product label contains the SKU 40634

Defect: The carrier stand hinge may be missing one or two bolts, which may cause the stand to be unstable.

Hazard: An unstable stand can result in a child falling or the carrier tipping over when placing a child in or out of the carrier, increasing the risk of serious injury to the child.

What to do: Check your carrier's stand hinge for the missing bolts according to the instructions in 'How to check your carrier' (attached below). If the bolts are missing (or you are in any doubt), immediately stop using the carrier and contact your nearest Kathmandu store to organise a free inspection and repair. If your carrier is not affected, please let Kathmandu know via the contact details below.

How to check your carrier

Correctly Assembled Product:



Step 1:

Check left and right side



Step 2:

Outer view – check bolt and washer are in place at top and bottom (you will need to pull back fabric to view)



Step 3:

Open the front lower zip to access inside the carrier



Step 4:

Inner view – check nut and washer are securely fastened top and bottom

Incorrectly Assembled Product:



Bolt and washer missing
