Panasonic CR2016 Lithium coin battery 3V

Dates sold: 1 June 2022 – 21 April 2023



Why the product is recalled: The product was sold without a warning label that is required for products containing button/coin batteries. This warning label may be missing from the battery.

Hazard: There is a risk of choking, severe internal burn injuries or death to young children if they gain access to the button batteries and ingest them.



1. Consumers should immediately stop using the battery and keep it out of reach of children. Return the product to the place of purchase for a full refund or replacement.
