

# Product Safety Recall

Dick Smith Electronics takes product safety very seriously and wishes to advise customers of a product recall of the DSE brand 7 inch portable DVD player model numbers G7152 and G7153.

The black model of the affected product is pictured below.

These products have been sold in the following colours : black (G7152) and white (G7153) in Dick Smith Electronics / Powerhouse / Tandy stores and authorised dealers nationwide since Oct 2007 to May 2010 .

Once removed from the packaging the items can be identified by the model identification (G7152 & G7153) on the rating label which is located on the bottom of the product.

## Defect

In rare cases the internal lithium-Ion rechargeable battery may overheat.

## Hazard

Overheating batteries are a potential fire hazard.

Dick Smith Electronics has not received any reports of injuries associated with this issue. No other DSE brand portable DVD players are affected by this recall.

**What to do:** Customers are asked to immediately stop using the product and return it to your nearest Dick Smith Electronics Store for a replacement or full refund.

**Comment:** The design of a recall notice must:

- ⊕ be a minimum size of 12 cms x 3 columns
- ⊕ use the red hatched boarder with the red safety triangle in the upper left hand corner – this is an internationally recognised safety symbol
- ⊕ use the headline 'Product Safety Recall' in red and 16 point font
- ⊕ use 10 point, Sans serif typeface in the body with bold section headings as above
