

VEHICLE PART PRODUCT SAFETY RECALL

MICHELIN 305/70 R22.5 XZE2+

Michelin Australia Pty Ltd has decided to voluntarily recall a limited amount (approx. 1900) of truck tyres **MICHELIN 305/70 R22.5 XZE2+** in Australia after its quality monitoring process showed that a limited number of tyres within this production range may present a risk of reduced crown endurance, which may lead to a rapid loss of air pressure.

The recalled tyres were produced between November 2008 and April 2010 and have the Dept. of Transportation tyre identification number which begins with **DOT HA 3M BJC X** and ends with the last four digits **4508 to 1510** inclusive. The DOT number can be found on the inner or outer sidewall of the tyre just above the wheel rim and are printed in small type. Michelin tyres outside these parameters are not affected by this recall.

The recall starts 23 June 2010. Owners can call Michelin on the customer service line below or return to their point of purchase for a free inspection and free replacement of tyres covered by the recall.
