

Product Safety Recall



PRODUCT: “RUBBER HEAT WATER BAG” HOT WATER BOTTLES

DEFECT: The hot water bottles did not have the required thickness of rubber as required in the Trade Practices (Consumer Product Safety Standard) (Hot Water Bottles) Regulations 2008. In addition the hot water bottle did not contain the following warning and instructions as required:

The warning message “Do not use boiling water” was not permanently marked on the bottle.

The following warning messages were not accompanying the product:

‘Warning - Hot Water Bottles Can Cause Burns’ “Avoid prolonged direct contact with the skin’ and ‘This hot water bottle is designed to be partly filled’

HAZARD: There is concern that this hot water bottle may leak, split or burst causing injury. In addition due to incorrect labelling consumers could misuse the product.

DATES SUPPLIED: July 2009 - June 2011.

WHAT TO DO: Consumers should cease using this product immediately and return to this store to obtain a full refund.
