



Product Safety Recall

Fisher-Price® Kawasaki Dora the Explorer Tough Trike toddler tricycles. Approximately 1,229 units of the affected product were sold at Toys 'R' Us in Australia in 2007-2008.



Description: Mattel® is recalling the Fisher-Price® Kawasaki Dora the Explorer Tough Trike toddler tricycles. This trike is intended for children 2 to 5 years of age. The Fisher-Price® Kawasaki Dora the Explorer Tough Trike includes a pretend key that is located about 3 inches (7½ centimeters) in front of the seat and protrudes at least 5/8 inches (1½ centimeters) above the trike's body. The model number is K6672 and is located under the seat in the storage compartment.

Any Fisher-Price® Trike with a key located on the handle bars is not affected by this recall.

Hazard: A child can strike, sit or fall on the protruding plastic ignition key, resulting in serious groin injury.

What to do: Please discontinue use of the affected Trike immediately and Contact Mattel® for a repair kit, a refund or a replacement product. Consumers should not return the product to retail stores.
