

# ELECTRICAL PRODUCT SAFETY RECALL

## Fujitsu LifeBook® incorporating Panasonic Battery Packs:



### Hazard

Fujitsu LifeBook laptop PCs shipped to Australia in 2012 with Model Numbers **E752, P702, S792, SH792**, and replacement batteries purchased after December 2011 for Model Numbers **H730, P772, P701, P771, P770, P8110, T580, S752, PH701, PH702, S710, SH572, SH762, SH771, SH772, TH550, S762**. For laptops and batteries purchased outside of Australia please visit [www.fujitsu.com](http://www.fujitsu.com). In rare instances battery packs manufactured by Panasonic Corporation may overheat and pose a fire risk and a burn hazard to users.

### Affected Battery Packs:

Battery packs labelled with the following product numbers and partial serial numbers are subject to recall and replacement.

Part Number (P/N)	Partial Serial Number
CP556150-01	Z110802 to Z111212
CP556150-02	Z120102 to Z120512

**What To Do:** Turn the computer off, unplug the AC adapter and remove the battery pack. Check the Part Number and Serial Number on the battery pack to see if they match the listed part number or partial serial number above. If they match, do not use this battery pack. The Part Number and Partial Serial Number are printed beneath the barcode on a sticker attached to the battery pack, as shown above. Please check the areas marked in **RED**.
