

Product Safety Recall

Woolworths Homebrand Bleach

Woolworths takes product safety very seriously and wishes to advise customers of a product recall of Homebrand Bleach 2L Regular (033270) and Homebrand Bleach 2L Lemon (008959)

The affected product has been sold in Woolworths, Safeway, Food for Less and Flemings stores nationwide from 27 November 2014 to 26 February 2015.

Defect: Affected products have small pin sized holes along the seam near the bottom of the bottle which may cause a slow leak of the contents.

Hazard: Bleach is a poisonous substance. If it leaks from the bottle and is left unattended, the contents can collect overtime and may come into contact with a user or bystander potentially causing personal injury and/or damage property.

What to do: Customers should wear gloves and immediately dispose of the Homebrand Bleach by flushing down the sink with plenty of running water and wipe any affected areas with a damp white cloth. Customers need to rinse the bottle and cap with water and present the rinsed out bottle and or a purchase receipt to any Woolworths, Safeway, Food for Less or Flemings store for a full refund.
