

Product Safety Recall

Maclaren Strollers



Product Description:

Maclaren strollers with a manufacturing date up to and including 2009 under the model names; Vogue, Volo, Triumph, Quest Sport, Quest Mod, Ryder, Techno XT, Techno XLR, Twin Triumph, Twin Techno, Daytripper, Techno Classic, Quest and Twin Traveller.

Note: This recall **does not** affect models manufactured from 2010 that includes the new round style folding hinge which can be identified by the Maclaren brand which is printed on the side hinge mechanism.

Hazard:

There is a potential if the warnings and instructions supplied with the Maclaren stroller are not followed during unfolding or folding the main side hinges may pose a risk of injury to a finger including possible crushing or amputation.

Maclaren expresses to consumers that care should always be taken with all prams and strollers when folding or unfolding them as there are potentials for injury to occur between moving parts in most product folding mechanisms.

What to do:

Maclaren is restating its 2009 and 2011 offer to consumers of a free kit that includes hinge covers, additional warnings that can be attached to the stroller and instructions on how to fit the covers. The hinge covers can be easily fitted by consumers there is no need to return your stroller.

Consumers can continue to use their stroller whilst waiting on the hinge kit and should ensure that when they fold or unfold their stroller as outlined by existing warnings and instructions; children are kept clear of the stroller and folding mechanisms until secured.
