

# Product Safety Recall

**IKEA recalls LATTJO Bat cape due to risk of strangulation or injuries to the neck.**



**IKEA urges customers who have a LATTJO Bat cape to immediately stop children from playing with it and to bring it back to any IKEA store for a full refund.**

The LATTJO Bat cape has been sold in all IKEA markets except Russia and Indonesia since November 2015.

**Defect:** IKEA is recalling the LATTJO Bat cape after reports three children have received marks and scratches on the neck while using a LATTJO Bat cape. The cape got stuck and the fastening did not detach easily enough from the neck of the children.

**Hazard:** No injuries which required medical treatment have been reported, but due to the risk of strangulation or injuries to the neck, IKEA recalls the product.

**What to do:** IKEA is not willing to risk children's safety and therefore urges all customers who have a LATTJO Bat cape to immediately stop children from playing with it and to bring it back to any IKEA store for a full refund.

The LATTJO Bat cape can be returned to any IKEA store for a full refund. Proof of purchase (receipt) is not required.
