

Product Safety Recall

IKEA recalls LATTJO drum sticks and LATTJO tongue drum, possible choking hazard



IKEA urges customers who have LATTJO drum sticks and LATTJO tongue drum to immediately stop using the toy and return it to any IKEA store for a full refund.

Defect: This is a precautionary recall due to 6 reports that the rubber ball of the drum sticks can detach or be unscrewed.

Hazard: A loose rubber ball can attract smaller children and in worst case lead to choking. No incidents have been reported. LATTJO drum sticks and LATTJO tongue drum have been sold in all IKEA markets since 1st November 2015.

What to do: IKEA urges all customers that have IKEA LATTJO drum sticks and LATTJO tongue drum to immediately stop using it and to return it to any IKEA store for a full refund. Proof of purchase (receipt) is not required for a full refund.
