## Reason the product is recalled

Blinder bicycle lights with an affected batch code contain lithium-ion batteries that may fail and catch fire.

## The hazards to consumers

Risk of serious burn injury & property damage if the battery catches fire. Incidents have occurred.

#### What consumers should do

- 1. Stop using the affected Blinder front bicycle light immediately.
- 2. Check the batch code using the Knog product recall portal.
- 3. If your light is affected, follow the instructions on the Knog product recall portal to receive a free replacement bike light.
- 4. Dispose of the affected bike light in accordance with local regulations for lithium-ion batteries. Improper disposal can lead to environmental hazards and safety risks.
