

## **Product Safety Recall**



## Do you own this product?

**Toshiba laptop AC Adapter** 

Dates sold: 01/04/2008 - 31/12/2015



Why the product is recalled: The material inside the adapter's DC-IN plug can degrade over time, which may cause the plug to overheat and catch fire.

**Hazard:** There is a risk of a serious burn injury or death and/or property damage if the adapter overheats and catches fire.

Multiple incidents have occurred globally resulting in burn injuries and damage to property.



- 1. Consumers should stop using Toshiba adapters immediately. Consumers should turn off power to their adapter at the wall socket and unplug it.
- Consumers should visit the Dynabook recall website <u>acadaptercheck.dynabook.com</u> to check if their adapter is recalled. Consumers with recalled adapters can use the website to register to return the adapter for a free replacement.
