

Product Safety Recall

MICHELIN 11R22.5 XDY3 148/145K TL Truck Tyre



Supplied in Australia between 1 October 2019 and 13 February 2020.

To determine if your tyre is subject to this recall, please:

1. Find the DOT Tyre Identification Number which is located on the sidewall of the tyre.
2. The DOT sequence begins with the code 3L3T. The last 4 digits of the DOT Tyre Identification Number is a date code which comprises of a 2-digit code for the week and a 2-digit code for the year of manufacture of the tyre. If your tyre's date code is between 3919 (inclusive) and 0520 (inclusive) your tyre is subject to this recall.

Defect: A manufacturing change resulted in micro air bubbles forming in and between certain components in the shoulder of the tyre. This may lead to rapid pressure loss or reduced performance in the tyre.

Hazard: If there is rapid pressure loss or the tyre degrades this may lead to tyre failure, resulting in a loss of vehicle control. This may increase the risk of an accident or injury to vehicle occupants and other road users.

What to do: Owners should return the affected tyre to the place of purchase or a Michelin authorised dealer for an inspection and replacement of the tyre, free of charge.
