Alpha and Sigma pot with a black nylon latch only

Sold by Sea to Summit between February 2019 to December 2019

Defect: The rotating swing handle on the cookware has a pivot-lock latching system to lock the handle in place for a secure grip when in use.

If the user fails to properly latch and lock the handle or if the latch releases, the pot could become unstable with a left handed pour.

Hazard: If the latch disengages, the pot may become unstable and this increases the risk of burns, scalding or serious injury.

What to do: Consumers should immediately stop using the affected cookware and contact Sea to Summit for a replacement latch. To identify the affected cookware, visit www.seatosummit.com/productsafety.
