

Product Safety Recall

Pedal Pacer 2



Sold nation-wide by 99 Bikes
between 1 December 2020 and 31 March 2021

Defect Affected bicycles may not meet the front hub retention requirements of the 'Trade Practices Act 1974 - Consumer Protection Notice No. 6 of 2004 - Consumer Product Safety Standard: Pedal Bicycles: Safety Requirements'.

The front wheel may dislodge from the front fork if the Quick Release Skewer is not properly tightened and secured.

Hazard If this occurs while the user is riding the bicycle, there is an increased risk of an accident or serious injury to the rider.

What to do Consumers should stop using the bicycle immediately and contact their local 99 Bikes retailer for a replacement fork fitted, a free upgrade to the Pedal Cavalier or a full refund.
