

Product Safety Recall

BVL 3-Point Seat Belts

Sold by Ray's Auto Seat Australia Pty Ltd
Sold between 2009 - 2012



Defect: These seat belts have been found to be unsafe through recent testing by the New Zealand Transport Agency. The seat belts can not effectively prevent injury in a car accident.

Hazard: In the event that the seat belts are in use during a car accident, they are unable to effectively protect occupants of the vehicle. Use of the seat belts may result in serious injury or death to occupants of the vehicle.

What to do: It is recommended that if BVL seat belts are fitted in the vehicle's driver seat, consumers do not use their vehicle until replacements are fitted. If fitted in other seating positions, passengers should not use those seats.
