DEFECT: The affected batches are contaminated with *Burkholderia cepacia* bacteria.

HAZARD: *Burkholderia cepacia* may cause serious infections or health complications in people with weakened immune systems.

WHAT TO DO: Consumers should immediately stop using the product. Consumers should take a photo showing the affected batch codes, then dispose of or destroy the product and contact Kimberly-Clark Australia to arrange for a replacement, gift card or refund.
