

## URGENT MEDICINE RECALL

### VICKS VAPORUB XTRA STRONG VAPORIZING OINTMENT 100g

Menthol 7% w/w, Eucalyptus oil 3.84% w/w

Following consultation with the Therapeutic Goods Administration, Procter & Gamble Australia Pty Ltd is recalling batch no. 222605 of Vicks VapoRub Xtra Strong 100g because some jars in this batch have been incorrectly labelled as Vicks VapoRub.

This recall does not affect any other batches of Vicks VapoRub Xtra Strong.

If you have a jar of Vicks VapoRub Xtra Strong 100g from batch 222605, do not use it.

Check the packaging carton or the jar label for the affected batch number. Alternatively, the affected product will have a VapoRub Xtra Strong red lid and the standard Vicks VapoRub ointment 100g label with a green element (as pictured).

Return it to the place of purchase for a refund or call our customer service line to arrange the return of affected product and refund.
