

# ELECTRICAL SAFETY RECALL

## Battery for eZee Electric Bikes 2016 - eZee Battery 19Ah



### IDENTIFICATION:

eZee Batteries sold from April 2016 - mid 2018. The battery serial numbers are labelled: LG MG1 D36200336.....

eZee 19Ah batteries with serial number Sony, Panasonic, BMZ, Sanyo are not affected by this recall

The batteries were sold at Glowworm Bicycles, Omafietts, Sydney Electric Bikes, Melbourne Electric Bikes, Cargo Cycles, Velo cycles, Perth Electric Bikes, Electric Bikes Brisbane, Teros and Cairns Electric Bikes

**DEFECT:** These batteries have been reported to catch alight while charging

**HAZARD:** The battery may overheat during charging and cause a fire.

**ACTION REQUIRED:** Remove your battery from the bike by turning the key-switch to the open position. Pull the battery both upwards and backwards to remove from the bike. Examine the serial number or take a photo and provide to your eZee bike dealer. Do not charge the battery if you have identified the battery as being part of the recall or if you are unsure. Store the battery until replaced at your local dealer in a location that poses a low fire risk, i.e. a garage
