

Product Safety Recall

IKEA is recalling TROLIGTVIS travel mug due to non-compliance with IKEA requirements



Defect: Testing has shown that dibutyl phthalate (DBP) may leach out of TROLIGTVIS travel mugs at above prescribed limits. During use of the travel mug the chemical may enter the liquid contained in the mug.

DBP is a chemical used to make plastics soft and pliable.

Hazard: Exposure to dibutyl phthalate (DBP) may result in adverse health effects.

What to do: IKEA urges all customers who have a TROLIGTVIS travel mug marked "Made in India" to stop using it and return the product to any IKEA store for a full refund. Proof of purchase (receipt) is not required.
