

Product Safety Recall

Promotional Keychain Torch SA Power Networks & Starlight Express Room



Free promotional product given by the Starlight Children's Foundation to children and families who used the Starlight Express Room at the Women's and Children's Hospital in Adelaide from 1 January 2011 and 31 December 2017.

Defect: The battery compartment is not adequately secured and the button batteries in the product are easily accessible.

Hazard: If young children gain access to the button batteries and ingest them, they may suffer internal burn injuries, which can result in serious illness and even death. In addition, the batteries may pose a choking hazard to young children.

What to do: If consumers have a torch, it should be destroyed immediately in a secure manner. If preferred, the torches may be returned to Starlight Children's Foundation where arrangements will be made for it to be securely destroyed.

After disposal, consumers should notify Starlight Children's Foundation so that the safe disposal of the products can be monitored.
