HOW TO DETERMINE IF YOUR RIFLE IS SUBJECT TO THE RECALL

Only Model 700 and Model Seven rifles with XMP triggers are being recalled.

To determine if your rifle is subject to this recall, you should take the following steps:

1. Find the rifle's serial number where the barrel meets the receiver. SEE GRAPHIC A
 - (a) for a right-handed rifle, the serial number is located on a user's left.
 - (b) for a left-handed rifle, the serial number is located on the user's right.

2. Identify the serial number and enter it at www.xmprecall.remington.com You will be informed if your rifle is affected by this recall.
3. You may also determine if your rifle is subject to the recall by a visual inspection.
 - (a) if the face of the trigger is ribbed (see Photo (1) below), your rifle does not have an XMP trigger and is NOT subject to this recall.
 - (b) if the face of the trigger is smooth (see Photo (2) below), your rifle has an XMP trigger and IS subject to this recall.
