

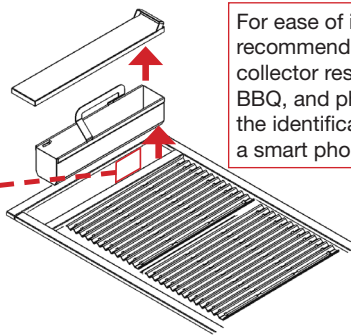
# Product Safety Recall

Smeg Australia Pty Ltd is initiating a recall on specified Smeg built-in BBQs sold in Australia through various retailers.



**Which models are affected?** Smeg built-in BBQ models BIBQ1205AF and BIBQ1205AH purchased after 26th July, 2013.

**Where to find the model number on the BBQ?** The model identification number can be found on the inside left of the BBQ, beside the fat collector as shown below.



For ease of identification, we recommend removing the fat collector reservoir from the BBQ, and photographing the identification sticker with a smart phone.

## Product Issue

In some circumstances, an internal gas feeder pipe may fail, potentially creating a fire hazard.

## Hazard: Risk of Fire

## What to do

Cease using the BBQ immediately and turn the gas off at the source. Disconnect from gas bayonet or gas bottle. Check the BBQ model number and contact Smeg Service to arrange a free, in-home repair.
