

Product Safety Recall

“TOYS” Dummy

On the advice of the NSW Office of Fair Trading, Hornsby Homebase is conducting a voluntary recall of the “TOYS” Dummy.

The pacifier does not comply with the mandatory requirements of the Australian standard. Of particular concern is the size of the shield which has the capacity to block the airways of a young child. In addition the teat and ring on the dummy can detach and create a choking hazard.



This dummy was sold at this store between October 2008 and June 2009. Consumers should cease using this dummy immediately and destroy or return to this store to receive a full refund.
